**Pharmacy College Admission Test Data**

All applicants receive their PCAT scores directly from the testing agency. Details related to the PCAT scoring may be obtained directly from the PCAT website at [www.PCATweb.info](http://www.PCATweb.info). You may also view your test scores by logging into your 'Profile' on the PCAT site. Only scores from January 2012 to January 2016 are valid for the 2016 admission cycle.

If an applicant's scores on the PCAT components listed below are equal to or greater than each of the values listed below, *and* if academic performance meets preliminary standards, an applicant remains within the eligible pool and is invited to attend an interview. Please view 'Notifications' on the Applicant website to view your personal notice confirming whether or not you have been selected for an interview.

**Minimum PCAT score requirements for 2016**

Conventions of Language ( <i>applicable to tests taken prior to July 2012</i> )	3.0
Problem Solving ( <i>applicable to tests taken prior to July 2012</i> )	2.5
Writing ( <i>applicable to tests taken July 2012 or later</i> )	3
Composite Percentile	50
Chemistry percentile	50
Biology percentile	20
Quantitative Ability percentile	20
Reading Comprehension percentile	25
Verbal Ability percentile	25

These conservative preliminary PCAT score thresholds were met by 80 percent of a pool of 730 applicants; however, subsequent to interviews and during final selections, the Faculty may raise minimum PCAT requirements at its discretion. Although the total number of applicants is very similar to last year (2015) the slight increase this year in the required scores for Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension were required to yield the same percentage of the applicant pool as the lower cuts yielded in past years.

If you had multiple test attempts please note that the test with the highest composite score, where minimums in all sections are met, is used in our calculations. Scores from different test administrations cannot be combined.
